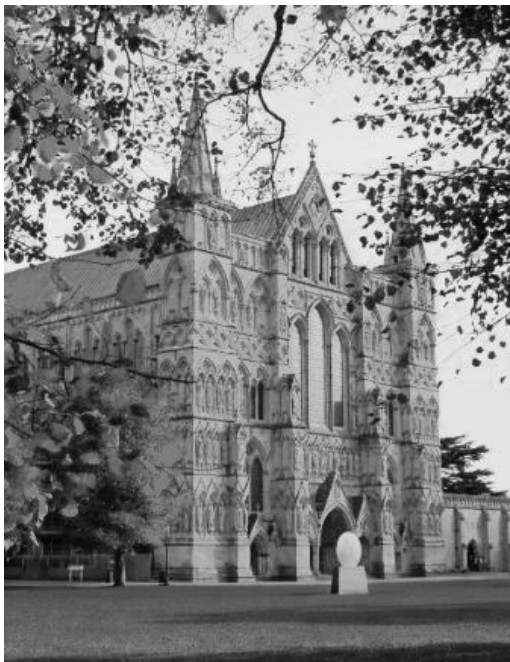
## **Flower Arranging: Simply Spring** **Wednesday 21 April 2010**

## Architectural Photography

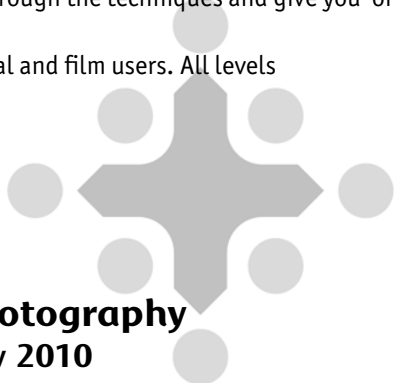
Tuesday 15 June 2010
