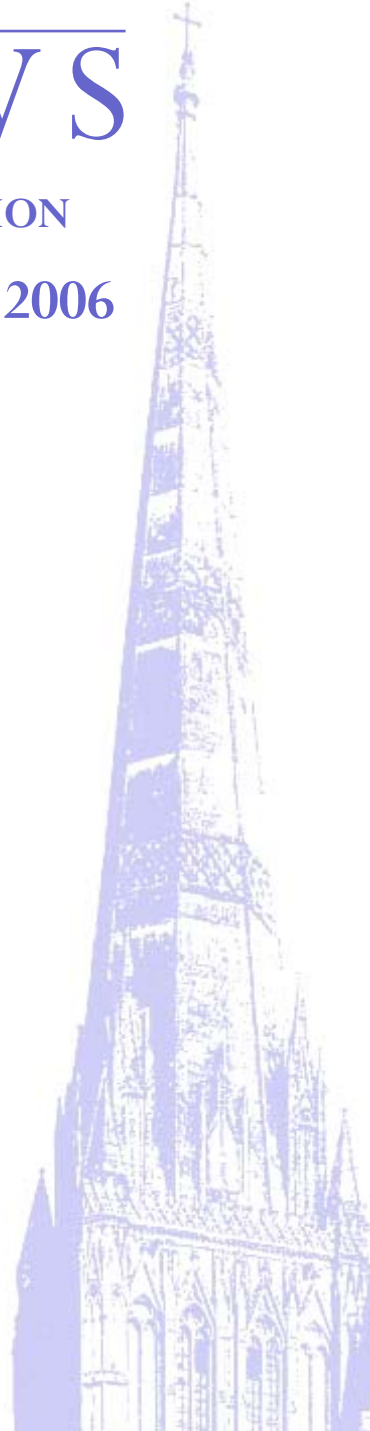

**Advent Procession
From Darkness to Light
December 2 and 3 at 7.00pm
and
Christmas Carol Services
December 20 and 21 at 7.00pm**

The Advent service begins in total darkness and silence as the Advent Candle is lit at the West End. During the service the Cathedral is illuminated by almost 1300 candles.

The Christmas Carol Service is the Cathedral's own carol service with a mixture of readings, carols sung by the choir and the great congregational carols for all to join in.

For those who wish to arrive early for these services and queue undercover, seasonal refreshments are available in the Cloisters. Access to the cathedral at 6.00pm is only available via the Cloisters.

No tickets are required and seats cannot be held for others. Please note for health and safety there can be no admission once all seats are taken.

There is no public parking in The Close; however, parking will be made available for Disabled Blue Badge holders.
