Add to all this Stainer *I Saw the Lord* on June 19th and Langlais *Messe Solennelle* on June 26th and we have a spectacular selection of music for May and June.

As always we are extremely grateful to the visiting choirs who join us for the next two months. In particular, we are very grateful to the Farrant Singers who join us for Ascension Day on June 2nd. They will be performing Padilla's *Missa Ego flos campi*, which is a wonderful piece of New World Polyphony, coupled with *Viri Galilaei* by Patrick Gowers which features a virtuosic organ duet accompaniment.
